## Know Before You Travel

All USVI visitors and residents are asked to follow the governmental guidelines for safe travel, and to take responsibility for your own health, as well as the health and safety of those around you.

**Every traveler (visitors AND residents) age five and older who enters the U.S. Virgin Islands is required to obtain approval from the USVI Travel Screening Portal AND to submit a COVID-19 test result prior to travel. ## Upon Arrival



You will be screened and have your **temperature** taken at the airport.



You must present your approval from the USVI Travel Screening Portal




Passengers may be **screened and quarantined** by the Department of Health based on initial screening and questionnaire results.

## Top Safety Guidelines



### Masks or facial coverings:

“No Mask, No Service” is the current motto here in the USVI for all businesses, public areas, accommodations and transportation, so please come prepared.



### Social distancing:

All businesses are required to physically distance patrons. Please keep 6 feet away from others not in your travel party both indoors and outdoors, including on the beaches.



### Sanitizing and Disinfecting:

All businesses are following strict safety and hygiene protocols by sanitizing all frequently touched surfaces at regular intervals..



Do your part by washing your hands often, and covering your cough/sneeze with your elbow or a tissue. Use hand sanitizer or hand wash stations wherever they are provided by businesses, restaurants, shops and transportation/tour operators.
